JCarlos A. Cuevas, Ph.D. is a Professor and Co-Director of the Violence and Justice Research Laboratory at Northeastern University in the School of Criminology and Criminal Justice.

Dr. Cuevas's research is in the area of victimization and trauma, sexual violence, family violence, and the overlap between victimization and delinquency. Specifically, his work focuses examining victimization among Latinos and how it relates to psychological distress, service utilization, and the role cultural factors play on victimization.

His most recent NIJ-funded research examines the scope and impact of bias crime against Latinos. As a clinical psychologist he also provides assessment and treatment to trauma survivors and victims of violence
