



Amy Bonomi, Harborview Injury Prevention and Research Center

Dr. Amy Bonomi is an award-winning professor formerly with The Ohio State University and Michigan State University, and currently an affiliate at the Harborview Injury Prevention and Research Center.

Dr. Bonomi's research focuses on gender-based violence prevention, sex-based discrimination prevention, and bias impacting minoritized populations. Her work on domestic violence recantation is used extensively in U.S. courts to educate juries on the counterintuitive nature of domestic violence and bias commonly directed towards survivors.

Based on her impact in violence prevention, Dr. Bonomi received the Distinguished Scholar Award from The Ohio State University's College of Education and Human Ecology and was the Diversity Champion (Women's History) in the College of Social Science at Michigan State University.

In 2019, Dr. Bonomi co-edited, *Women Leading Change in Academia: Breaking the Glass Ceiling*, Cliff and Slipper. Endorsed by the American Psychological Association and receiving the 2020 Most Promising New Textbook Award, *Women Leading Change* convenes the narratives of women leaders on bias, sexism, and racism in academia.
