**Level 2** – Builds upon Level 1 (prerequisite to Level 2) with deeper dive into SER / ESTAR, TENER, stem-changing verbs and an introduction into indirect object pronouns with Gustar, etc. Themes of family and travel. *\*offered in Spring 2017* 

**Level 3** – Builds upon Level 2 (prerequisite to Level 2) with emphasis mostly on conversation. Introduces past tense verbs with themes of current events.
