2017 Fall NEW course at Chillicothe:

"This is Most Certainly True: Experiencing Martin Luther's Small Catechism for Today"

Dates: September 16; October 28 November 18, 2017

Instructor: The Rev. Suzanne Darcy-Dillahunt, Bishop of the Southern Ohio Synod, Evangelical Lutheran Church in America. Bishop Dillahunt was elected Bishop of the Southern Ohio Synod June 2013 and began serving as Bishop in September 2013. She received her undergraduate degree, a BA in Political Science with a minor in Sociology at the University of Arizona May 1981 and was awarded a M.Div. by Trinity Lutheran Seminary in 1986. Prior to her election as Bishop, she served for 17 years as Assistant to the Bishop of SO Synod. She has served as pastor or co-pastor in congregations in Springfield, Gahanna and Eaton Ohio.

Course description: The course will consider the importance of Luther's Small Catechism for faith formation in Christian households and how the principles found in the Small Catechism impact faith in daily life. The student will become familiar with one of the chief texts of the Lutheran Confessional movement and will be able to make use of the Small Catechism as guide for discipleship in one's own life. The class will consist of learning modules, group discussion and activity, assigned readings and small group interaction.

Texts: <u>The Small Catechism</u>, latest annotated version offered by Augsburg Fortress and Living in the Kingdom by Alvin Rogness
