

#### "DARING WOMEN OF THE REFORMATION"

In October we wrapped up our year with our 2017 Convention.

Out of all of the Fun, Bible Study, Learning about Daring Women of the Reformation, Good food, Fun, Shopping, and Fun. Then it was our turn to be Daring. We passed a few resolutions:

#### Resolution 1

#### Resolved that SOS Women of the ELCA add Anti-Human Trafficking as a line item in the budget.

Marcia Calhoun moved the adoption of the resolution. Seconded by Cheri Comstock.

Discussion followed. It was pointed out that Anti-Human Trafficking is a line item in the budget under the Expense/Disbursements heading of "Leadership". It was also pointed out that anyone or group can make a designated gift to be used for Anti-Human Trafficking and it will then appear in the budget as a line item under "Benevolence". It was also clarified that the line item for Anti-Human Trafficking would remain as such under "Leadership" and the Benevolence line would be additional money for the program. The signers of the resolution agreed that would fulfill their intention. No further action was needed.

#### Resolution 2

#### Resolved that SOS Women of the ELCA add a task force to study and react to the opioid crisis in our state.

Marcia Calhoun moved the adoption of the resolution. Seconded by Emma Barnaclo.

Discussion followed. Bishop Suzanne Dillahunt pointed out that the Southern Ohio Synod has established a task force in conjunction with the Archdioceses of Cincinnati, The United Methodist Church and others studying the opioid crisis in Southwestern Ohio. The signers of Resolution 2 agreed that SOS WELCA supporting this task force would fulfill the intention of the resolution.

The amended Resolution 2 now reads: Resolved that SOS Women of the ELCA support the synodical task force to study and react to the opioid crisis in our state.

Motion to accept the amended resolution passed unanimously.

We had an election and now we have a new board minus a treasurer which is still needed. Please prayerfully consider this position. Being on the board is a wonderful experience. Anyone with a little Excel knowledge and a commitment to attend events would be able to handle this position.

Please see the new listing of officers on the back page. I am looking forward to coming to my Spring Gathering in Cincinnati Conference to find out what our new board has been doing with these resolutions.
