

2018 Young Adult Horizon Apprenticeship Program Nomination Form

June 10 – August 4, 2018

Program Description: In Baptism all young people are called by God into the community of Jesus, the church. From Baptism and beyond it is the responsibility of the young person's family and church community to help them grow in faith and reflect on what it means to be in school and be a Baptized child of God. This program is designed to help young people of color or whose primary language is that other than English acquire a missional imagination that will help them begin to discern their future, and the role that Jesus and the church will have in their life. Each student participant will receive a stipend of \$1,500 for the summer.

Program Expectations:

- This program is intended for high school and college students. Students MUST be enrolled in high school or college and be between the ages of 16 and 20 for the entirety of the program.
- The commitment is for nearly 2 months, beginning June 10th – August 4th, at 20+ hours per week.
- The pastor of the student's home congregation will serve as the student's mentor and will include them in worship, bible study and other aspects of congregational life. Each student participant will work with their mentor to develop and implement a project for the summer (i.e. Bible study, sermon, community or congregational project).
- The student will attend a workshop in another city for two to three days this summer. More details to come.
