Research shows of the 2.6 million Iraq and Afghanistan Veterans, 1/2 need some sort of support. For instance:  
• **40% have difficulty finding meaning, purpose or getting in touch with spirituality.**

• 55% feel disconnected from civilian life

• 1/2 - 1/4 are frustrated with:

\* Social functioning (Making non military friend.)

\* Productivity (Finding and keeping their next career.)

\* Community involvement
