

St. John's Lutheran Church- Philo Guidelines

- If you have a fever, other symptoms of Covid-19, have been in contact with anyone who have similar symptoms or have been diagnosed with active Covid-19. Please stay home.
 - All attendees will maintain good Hygiene practice and 6' distancing at all times.
 - Entry doors will be propped open before service. Exit following service through rear Handicap door.
 - Guidelines will be posted on entrance doors
 - Masks are recommended for congregation
 - Floor of Sanctuary marked for Social Distancing
 - Pews taped off for distancing.
 - No hand shaking (sharing of peace)
 - No Greeter when entering church.
 - Offering Plate will be placed in Narthex
 - Bulletins spread individually on table near Narthex
 - Masks not required for Pastor or lay leaders who are socially distanced from the congregation, while delivering service or readings from chancel area, pulpit, altar or lectern.
 - No Children's Sermon or activities during regular Sermon (Children will remain with family)
- Use sanitizer when entering or exiting the church building for personal safety.
- Sanctuary, Narthex, Vestibule, Restrooms, and all hand surfaces sanitized after each gathering.
 - All services require adherence to social distancing, and health guidelines.
 - Hymnals will be assigned to individuals.
 - Noted that ALL Attendees upon entry to the building and attend services are at their own risk during the COVID-19 pandemic.
