- Get paid to attend a mandatory training class (rates vary according to position) and participate in hands-on instruction
- Get paid to attend a *PRACTICE MAKES PERFECT* 'OPEN HOUSE' during the weekend before the election
- Work from 5:30 a.m. – 8:30 p.m. or later on Election Day
- Get paid to work Election Day (\$133.72)
- Receive your pay approximately 3 weeks after the election
