Dr. Charles Peterson, of St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Milwaukee, Wisconsin (2000-2005) and as pastor of First English Lutheran Church in Tyrone, Pennsylvania (1991-1997). She is the author of *Who is the Church? An Ecclesiology for the Twenty-First Century* (Fortress Press, 2013) and numerous articles and book

chapters. Her current research focuses on the work and role of the Holy Spirit in the life of the Christian and the world, in dialogue with Pentecostalism and those who claim to be "spiritual but not religious."

The Rev. Dr. Cheryl Peterson is a dynamic speaker and thoughtful theologian. Attendees of the February 11 Rostered Leader Theological Education Event will have ample material for dialogue and reflection.
